The projects on Cebula's web site include interiors from a wide variety of properties, including these:

- **A multi-million dollar new home in Dover, NH**, overlooking a nearby river that the owners have called "a dream come true" because of its fulfilling their vision for a spectacular blue summer house.
- **A 16,000 sq/ft new ocean-side estate built around views of Nubble Light in York, Maine** that fulfills the owners' life-long dream of living near this landmark, with four grand floors of living space, guest and nanny accommodations, and a picturesque rotunda.
- **A 4,000 sq/ft, three-bedroom contemporary loft in SoHo, NY** that is designed to blend the owner's Indian ancestry with her young, hip New York artsy personality, including the crowning touch of an exquisite princess bedroom.
- **A York Harbor, ME renovation** after a devastating fire to a 1900s home designed by classical architect John Russell Pope. Antique pieces of the original home – such as

strips of wood paneling, lighting fixtures, doorknobs, hinges, and plumbing fittings – were rescued, refinished, and incorporated in a manner that pays homage to the original design.

- **A 25,000 sq/ft hideaway on Lake Winnepesaukee in Wolfeboro, NH** that is fit for royalty (it was the vacation destination of French president, Nicolas Sarkozy, in 2007). This residence includes such unique attributes as eight individually themed bedrooms, a 15-seat media room, a 13-foot wide chandelier, and a hot tub inside a two-story tower with panoramic lake views.
- An **English-style country home in Concord, MA** which was previously a '60s contemporary house with Olympic size swimming pool. With the pool converted into living and dining rooms, Cebula, along with the owners and their architects, were able to preserve such outstanding features as rare and hard-to-find Jerusalem limestone tiles.

The site also features Cebula's **commercial** work, including lobbies and offices in banks around New England.
